▼ **Regional Activity:** A moderate earthquake measuring M4.4 occurred mid Friday morning about 15 miles southeast of Hawthorne in the Garfield Hills. Residents felt a sharp jolt (P-wave) followed by a few seconds of rolling motion (S-wave). It was also felt as far away as Fallon, Minden and Carson City. There were no reports of items toppling from tables or shelves. It was followed by a few aftershocks, three of which registered in the M2 range.

▼ Fifteen quakes were recorded in the Fish Lake Valley seismic zone, including one as large as M3.8.

▼ **Mammoth Lakes Activity:** Service to a microwave tower disabled the local seismic monitoring network on April 21-23. However, the regional network detected a M3.0 event during the outage.
